



Level 1 training

1-hour introduction to human trafficking and the healthcare professional

The purpose of level 1 training is to raise awareness among healthcare professionals on the issue of human trafficking.

Level 1 training will include:

- Definition of human trafficking and subtypes of trafficking including:
 - International labor trafficking
 - International sex trafficking
 - Domestic labor trafficking
 - Domestic sex trafficking
- Overview of the scope of human trafficking across the world and within the U.S.
- Basic description of venues of human trafficking
- Predisposing factors and vulnerabilities of trafficking
- Importance of the interface between healthcare and trafficking
- General indicators of trafficking within the healthcare setting
- General initial steps to take to prepare to respond to victims of human trafficking encountered in the healthcare setting

Educational objectives for a level 1 training

At the conclusion of this program, participants should be able to:

- Describe the scope and general characteristics of human trafficking in the U.S.
- Recognize the common indicators and high-risk factors for human trafficking.
- Initially assess whether a patient may be a victim of human trafficking.
