The Clinical Director will stay up-to-date with all new research and trends in the field and ensure they're applied in Hope for Justice programs.</p>

<p>Clinical program development and oversight at all locations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Co-facilitate the group therapy program at Dream Home and oversee its expansion into STAR House. • Oversight of STAR House and Bridge clinical programming, case management and any necessary therapeutic or emergency clinical services. <p>Supervision, Management and Training</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide clinical oversight, support and supervision to staff responsible for case management and therapeutic work with clients, including all client-related case management decisions, treatment planning, therapeutic interventions, and milieu care. <p>Direct Client Care and Oversight</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide trauma therapy through translation on a weekly basis in collaboration with and for the purpose of direct field mentoring for clinical social work staff. • Oversee treatment planning, therapeutic and termination processes as needed. • Creation and maintenance of client safety plans for shelter care and offsite as well as crisis management. 	

Client Referral and Clinical Intake Management

- Work closely with the Social Work Director and referral agencies to gain necessary information about potential client referrals as well as oversee the clinical component of the intake process and make any necessary updates or adjustments.

Monitoring and Evaluation, Research

- Assist in the ongoing monitoring, evaluation, and innovative development of Dream Home programming; complete and report client assessments every 4 months or as dictated by clinical need or M&E process.

Legal

- Liaise with partner organizations to ensure victim focused preparation, trial experiences and post-legal debrief.
